### Down on the Farm

July 6-10, 9:15 a.m.-1:15 p.m.

## Kindergarten Readiness

July 20-24, 9:15 a.m.-2:15 p.m.\*

This program is designed to help incoming kindergarteners transition from preschool into a more academic learning environment. The curriculum will focus on following directions, developing important pre-reading and pre-writing skills, learning to rotate in groups, and working independently in literacy and math centers. The lessons will follow an animal theme for the week.

Each week themes will be explored through crafts, snacks, stories, and games. The children will spend some time playing outside in our large fenced playground as weather permits and can escape the heat in our air-conditioned classrooms. Families must send a snack, packed lunch, and water bottle each day.

#### Registration

In addition to a registration form, we will need a copy of your child's Health Inventory once enrollment is confirmed. Make checks payable to GPNS and write the name of the program(s) and the student(s) you are registering for on the memo line. There are no refunds, but families can switch weeks, if space is available.

Children must be at least 3 years old by the start of the summer program they are attending and no older than 5 years old. All children **MUST** be fully potty trained.
